

LIFE GROUP BIBLE STUDY

Based on the message of Sunday, March 9th, 2025

Title: Blessed to Be a Blessing

1. Understanding God's Calling

"Now the Lord had said to Abram: 'Get out of your country, from your family and from your father's house, to a land that I will show you.'" - Genesis 12:1

Reflection: When God calls us, it is often out of our comfort zones. His calling is not about where we feel safe, but about where He wants to take us. Faith requires obedience before we see the full picture.

Question: What is something God has called you to step into that required faith and trust in Him?

2. Blessing with a Purpose

"I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing." - Genesis 12:2

Reflection: God's promise to Abram was not just about making him prosperous or successful—it was about making him a conduit of God's blessing to others. The blessings of God are never meant to stop with us but are intended to flow through us to impact the world.

Question: How can you use what God has given you—whether talents, resources, or experiences—to bless others?

3. Walking in Obedience to See God's Fulfillment

"I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed." - Genesis 12:3

Reflection: God's promise to Abram wasn't just about his own life—it was about the generations after him. His obedience paved the way for nations to be blessed, ultimately leading to the coming of Jesus Christ.

Abram didn't know all the details when he said yes—he just knew God was leading him. In the same way, we don't need to have all the answers, we just need to trust the One who is calling us.

Question: What is one step of faith God is asking you to take right now? How can you respond in obedience?
