

LIFE GROUP BIBLE STUDY

Based on the message of Sunday, March 23th, 2025

Title: Follow God

1. Even When It Doesn't Make Sense — Follow God

Example: Naaman being told to dip in the Jordan

Verse: 2 Kings 5:10 — “Go and wash yourself seven times in the Jordan River... and you will be healed.”

Reflection: God's instructions might not always make sense to your mind—but they always make miracles.

2. Even When You Can't See the Path — Follow God

Example: The blind man sent to the pool of Siloam

Verse: John 9:7 — “Jesus told him, ‘Go wash in the pool of Siloam.’ So the man went and washed and came home seeing.”

Reflection: You may not understand how it will happen, but when you follow Jesus, healing and clarity come.

3. Even When Nobody Understands — Follow God

Example: Mary saying yes to God's call

Verse: Luke 1:38 — “I am the Lord's servant. May everything you have said about me come true.”

Reflection: There are moments when obedience to God will make you misunderstood—by your friends, your family, even the people sitting beside you in church. But Mary's story teaches us that we don't need everyone to understand us— all we need to do is to **follow God**.

4. Even When You're Tired — Follow God

Example: Peter told to cast his net again

Verse: Luke 5:5 — “Master, we worked hard all last night and didn't catch a thing. But if you say so, I'll let the nets down again.”

Reflection: When your strength is gone but His word is clear, obedience is still the path to overflow.

5. Even When It Seems Impossible — Follow God

Example: The walls of Jericho

Verse: Joshua 6:20 — “When the people heard the sound of the rams' horns, they shouted... and the walls collapsed!”

Reflection: God doesn't need your logic—He needs your obedience. The breakthrough comes after the obedience.
