THE VOICE

Text: Matthew 10:20

For it is not you who speak, but it is the Spirit of your Father who speaks IN you.

Have you ever had a hunch? An impression about something, a feeling, like a sixth sense? Some people call it "gut feeling." Others call it intuition. But what if all these things were God trying to communicate with us? Adventurer, survivalist and author Bear Grills calls it "the voice." In his book, "Never Give Up," he says, "The voice is always right." What if all this time, throughout our entire lives, God has been trying to communicate with us? What if He talks to us way more than we think? And what if we acknowledged that and obeyed the "still small voice"? How different would our lives be?

LED BY GOD

Text: Mark 1:12

Immediately the Spirit impelled Him to go out into the wilderness.

Text: Romans 8:14

For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God.

A child holds the hands of their parents or caregivers to feel safe when crossing the road. We allow ourselves to be led by the ones we trust. When we trust God and take His mighty hand, he will guide us and lead us through the storm. The famous Psalm 23 says: "*though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.*" Note that we are not alone, not even when we go through our darkest hour, God is with us, and if we let Him, He will guide us. There is nothing better in life than being led by the Spirit of God. His plans for you are unique. Trust Him.

PEACE AND OPEN DOORS

Text: Collossians 3:15

The peace that Christ gives is to guide you in the decisions you make

Text: Revelations 3:7

When I open a door, no one can close it. And when I close a door, no one can open it.

Finally, there are two more ways God speaks to us:

Peace: God speaks to us through peace. God gives us a peace that "surpasses all understanding" (Philippians 4:6). Jesus promised to give us peace (John 14:27). If you don't have peace about something if it feels wrong, than it is not God's will for you. When God is in the situation, He will give you peace.

Doors: Another way God speaks and guides us to the center of His good and perfect will for our lives is to open and close doors. If you pray and ask Him for guidance, He will open the doors you are supposed to go through and close the doors which are not the best for you. You don't have to kick down doors God has for you. They will open with a swoosh before you as you come toward them.
