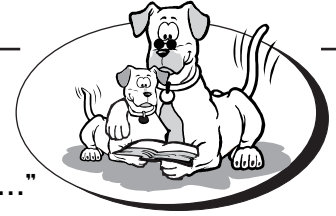


# 1 TWO KINGDOMS

"KID'S CARRYING THE KINGDOM"

## Heaven to Home WHAT WE LEARNED TODAY



Dear Parents:

Our Memory Verse this week:

"For Yours is the Kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever..."  
Matthew 6:13b

Today we discovered:

- That there are 2 kingdoms: Kingdom of Heaven, and the kingdom of darkness
- A kingdom is where a king rules and reigns
- A kingdom reflects the heart and character of the king
- God's Kingdom is greater than the kingdom of darkness
- God has invited us to be part of His Kingdom

Parents Points to Ponder:

This introductory lesson is foundational, and sets the stage for the journey our children are invited to experience. The revelation of the two kingdoms brings an understanding of good and evil: God's Kingdom is good and wonderful because God is good and wonderful, and the Kingdom of Darkness is evil because the devil is evil. This lesson also presents the truth that God loves them, and they can choose to belong to His Kingdom through the cross of Christ.

Ask Your Child:

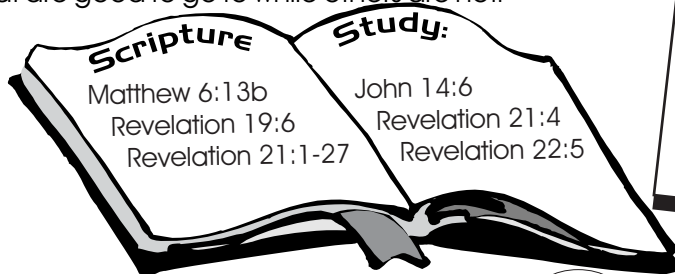
What the 2 kingdoms are and who are the rulers in each kingdom. Who's kingdom is greater? Ask them to describe what God's Kingdom is like. Let them share what their thoughts are about God's Kingdom.

Soaking Time:

Have a time where they can "soak" and ask God to show them His kingdom and what is in heaven. All it takes is a quiet place and some soft, instrumental worship music. (Please feel free to join your child in this soaking time).

Home Activity:

As you watch a TV show or movie, or as you travel or go to a store, ask your child to be aware of things that they see that reflect God's Kingdom or things that might be found in the "kingdom of darkness". This can provide a great opportunity to help them learn to discern and opens a door for you to share with them why you feel some things are good for them to watch, play with, or places that are good to go to while others are not.
