**Our Memory Verse this week:**

**Today we discovered:**

- **God's love is demonstrated in His will to heal**

**Parent's Points to Ponder:**

Our Father's desire for us to be physically well is such a foundational truth for our children to know and understand. Because He loves us, God sent His Son, Jesus, to not only take away our sin, but our sicknesses and diseases as well. Our children must realize the simple truth that sickness is bad, and that healing is good, and comes from God.

**Ask your child:**

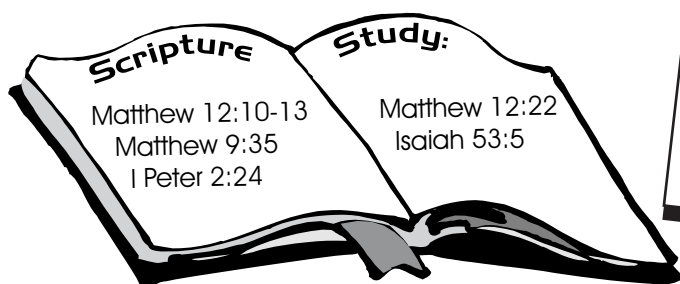
Where does sickness come from? (The enemy) Where does healing come from? (From a loving God) Why does God want us well? (He loves us and wants us to have good things)

**Home Activity:**

Review with your child one or more of the Scripture studies where Jesus healed someone. Share with them any healings that you have had or others you know.

In a soaking atmosphere, encourage your child to thank Papa God for His healing love. Thank Jesus for taking away pain and sickness on the cross.

Pray with your child for anyone you know that needs healing (hurting hearts count). You may want to post a list of names on the "Heaven's Window" bulletin board. Have them journal what happened when they prayed.
