



Dear Parents:

Our Memory Verse this week:

"... you shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover." Mark 16:8

Today we discovered:

- Jesus and His disciples healed the sick
- God has given us His power and authority
- We can pray for the sick too
- Healing is a sign that points to something greater: our Heavenly Father

Parent's Points to Ponder:

This lesson is a follow-up to "God's Healing Love", and is designed to equip children to fulfill Jesus' command to "lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover". It is so exciting to partner with Jesus and the Holy Spirit to prepare and release this young generation to bring Heaven to earth by the working of healing miracles!

Ask Your Child:

How does healing show God's Kingdom? What happens to the Kingdom of Darkness when someone gets healed? Who is glorified when pain and sickness goes away?

Home Activity:

Discuss with your child why we have God's anointing and authority, and how we can use them when we pray for the sick. Pray with your child for the opportunity to pray for a sick or hurting person this week (or if anyone in the family is not well, pray for them). Have your child journal what happened when they prayed.

Read and review with your child one or more of the scriptures (Matthew 9:35; Acts 3:1-10; Acts 9:33-35) where Jesus' followers prayed for and the sick were healed.
